Due Dates: Tuition and fees will be due December 15th.

Refunds: 100% during the first week minus \$100 withdrawal fee (January 5 – 10, 2010.)  
25% during the second week (January 11 – 17, 2010.) No refunds after January 17, 2010.

Withdrawal Fees: \$100.00 for any withdrawals occurring on or after December 22, 2009 through the end of the first week, January 10, 2010.

Financial Aid: Upon student request, UWC financial aid will add the cost of a student's winterim class to the spring term cost of attendance figure; this will maximize a student's loan eligibility. This applies only to those students who are not using their maximum loan eligibility during the academic year. It will not create new types of aid eligibility. There are no additional grant funds for winterim. Funds will not be disbursed until the regular spring term disbursement.

Add/Drop Dates: Last day to Add: January 6, 2010  
Last day to Drop/Withdraw: January 19, 2010
